*The Twelvefold Emphasis On The Deity Of Jesus
By Allusions To The Divine Name In The Gospel Of John*

The Messiah:

Jn 4:26 Jesus saith unto her, **I** that speak unto thee **am** *he*.

The One Who Is Able To Walk On The Sea (cf. Job 9:8):

Jn 6:20 But he saith unto them, It is **I**; be not afraid. [*lit. = "I am, do not be afraid"*]

The Bread Of Life That Came Down From Heaven:

Jn 6:35 And Jesus said unto them, **I am** the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

Jn 6:41 The Jews then murmured at him, because he said, **I am** the bread which came down from heaven.

Jn 6:48 **I am** that bread of life.

Jn 6:51 **I am** the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that **I** will give is my flesh, which **I** will give for the life of the world.

The Light Of The World:

Jn 8:12 Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, **I am** the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

I AM (The Son Who Has Power To Forgive Sins, Who Will Be Lifted Up, And Who Is Eternal)

Jn 8:18 **I am** one that bear witness of myself, and the Father that sent me beareth witness of me.

Jn 8:24 **I** said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that **I am** *he*, ye shall die in your sins.

Jn 8:28 Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that **I am** *he*, and *that* **I** do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, **I** speak these things.

Jn 8:58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, **I** say unto you, Before Abraham was, **I am**.

The Door Of The Sheep

Jn 10:7 Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, **I** say unto you, **I am** the door of the sheep.

Jn 10:9 **I am** the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.

The Good Shepherd

Jn 10:11 **I am** the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

Jn 10:14 **I am** the good shepherd, and know my *sheep*, and am known of mine.

The Resurrection And The Life

Jn 11:25 Jesus said unto her, **I am** the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:

I AM (The One Who Knows The Future)

John 13:19 Now **I** tell you before it come, that, when it is come to pass, ye may believe that **I am** *he*.

The Way, The Truth, And The Life

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, **I am** the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

The True Vine

John 15:1 **I am** the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman.

John 15:5 **I am** the vine, ye *are* the branches: He that abideth in me, and **I** in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.

I AM (The One Who Is Willingly Taken Away)

John 18:5 They answered him, Jesus of Nazareth. Jesus saith unto them, **I am** *he*. And Judas also, which betrayed him, stood with them.

John 18:6 As soon then as he had said unto them, **I am** *he*, they went backward, and fell to the ground.

John 18:8 Jesus answered, **I** have told you that **I am** *he*: if therefore ye seek me, let these go their way:
